Audubon's Corkscrew Swamp Sanctuary

Stroll through pine flatwoods and wet prairies into the largest old-growth Bald Cypress forest in North America. The sanctuary's most famous "resident" is the elusive ghost orchid – the largest that's ever been discovered.







Big Cypress National Preserve

Covering over 729,000 acres, this preserve is home to diverse wildlife. Go on a guided swamp walk, serene paddle or photo safari to take in the sights of this natural marvel.
